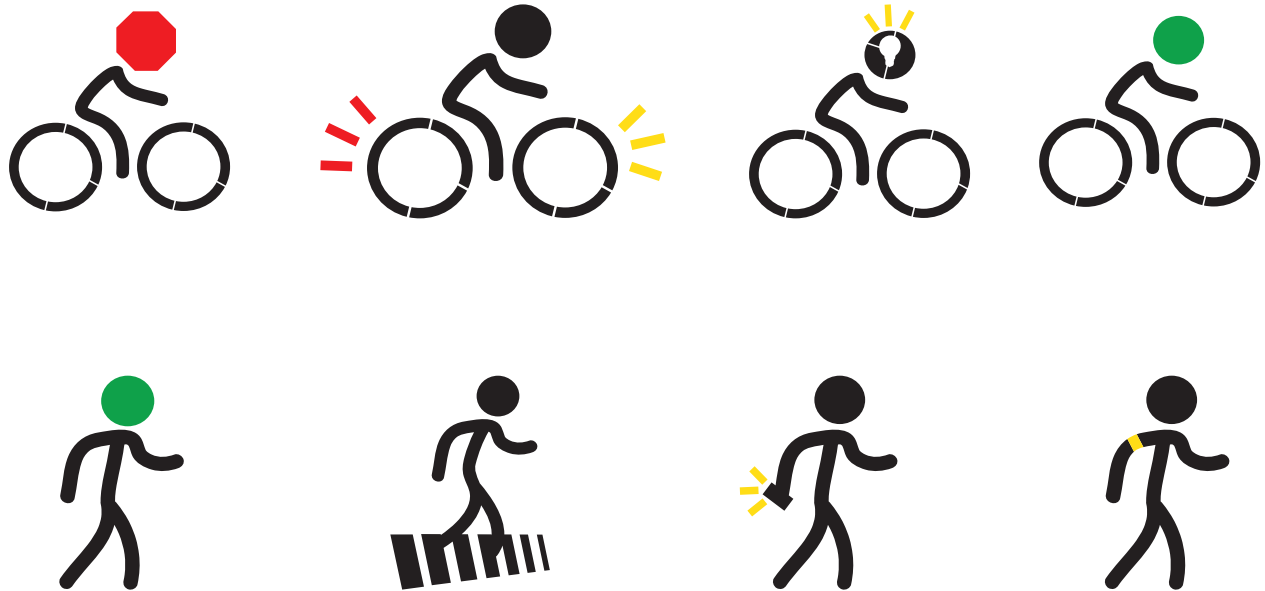


VISUAL GUIDE

for Local Motion Safe Streets stencils

includes graphic diagrams showing placement and colors as well as written instructions explaining how to paint stencils.



notes

Stencils are to be painted **ONLY on sidewalks.**

Stencils are NOT meant to be painted on asphalt or private property. This includes both graphic/illustration sizes and text.

All instructions are written for the illustration stencils.

Text stencils (the stencils containing words) are always painted solid white and accompany 30" x 30" graphics.

18" x 18" stencils are illustrations only.

The smaller illustration stencils are meant to be graphic only. NO WORDS. Specific instructions for individual graphics are explained on following pages.

30" x 30" stencils are paired with 30" wide text.

The larger illustration stencils are meant to be paired with the explanatory text stencils. Specific instructions for pairs are explained on following pages. These pairs are meant to be painted only at the designated areas listed with the instructions.

Small stencils are to be painted randomly around the city.

At least 2-3 of each graphic should be painted per block to insure people see the graphics and to raise interest for the large pairings painted at the designated areas. Again: ONLY PAINT STENCILS ON SIDEWALKS.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cover head with cardboard.
Spray paint body and wheels white.
2. Cover body and wheels with cardboard.
Spray paint head red.

DESIGNATED PAINTING AREA

At bike crossing areas with stop signs **SIDEWALKS ONLY**

BE BRIGHT AT NIGHT

COLORS

white

red

yellow

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Rotate stencil 45 degrees so bike is level (as shown in diagram below).
2. Cover all rectangles with cardboard.
Spray paint bicyclist white.
3. Cover bicyclist and front rectangles with cardboard.
Spray paint rear rectangles red.
4. Cover bicyclist and rear rectangles with cardboard.
Spray paint front rectangles yellow.

WAIT FOR THE LIGHT (bicyclist)

COLORS

white

green

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cover head with cardboard.
Spray paint body and wheels white.
2. Cover body and wheels with cardboard.
Spray paint head green.

DESIGNATED PAINTING AREA

At bike crossing areas with stop lights. (Any stop light intersection.)

WAIT FOR THE LIGHT (pedestrian)

COLORS

white

green

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cover head with cardboard.
Spray paint body white.
2. Cover body with cardboard.
Spray paint head green.

DESIGNATED PAINTING AREA

At pedestrian crossing areas with stop lights. (Any stop light intersection.)

COLORS

white

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Paint entire stencil white.

DESIGNATED PAINTING AREA

At any crosswalk. **SIDEWALKS ONLY**

STOP TEXTING AND LOOK UP

COLORS

white

yellow

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cover rectangles with cardboard.
Spray paint pedestrian white.
2. Cover pedestrian with cardboard.
Spray paint rectangles yellow.

DESIGNATED PAINTING AREA

At all pedestrian crossing areas. **SIDEWALKS ONLY**



**STOP TEXTING
AND LOOK UP**



stencil eight

BE BRIGHT AT NIGHT (pedestrian)

**COLORS**

white

yellow

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cover yellow rectangle with cardboard.
Paint entire pedestrian white.
2. Re-position stencil so the yellow rectangle (in the diagram) is lined up on the rear arm.
(Positioning shown in diagram to the right.)
Cover pedestrian with cardboard.
Paint rectangle yellow.
